Q Code	Meaning
QRL	The frequency is in use
QRM	Your transmission is being interfered with...
QRN	I am troubled by static (1-5)
QRO	Increase transmitter power
QRP	Decrease transmitter power
QRQ	Send faster (...words / minute)
QRS	Send more slowly (...words / minute)
QRT	Stop sending
QRU	I have nothing for you
QRV	I am ready to copy
QSL	I acknowledge receipt
QTH	My location is...
QRL?	Is the frequency in use?
QRM?	Is my transmission being interfered with?
QRN?	Are you troubled by static?
QRP?	Shall I decrease transmitter power?
